"heavy goods vehicle" means an articulated goods vehicle, or a large goods vehicle, that is to say, a motor vehicle (not being an articulated goods vehicle) which is constructed or adapted to carry or to haul goods and the permissible maximum weight of which exceeds 75 tonnes; "horse" includes mules and other beasts of burden
